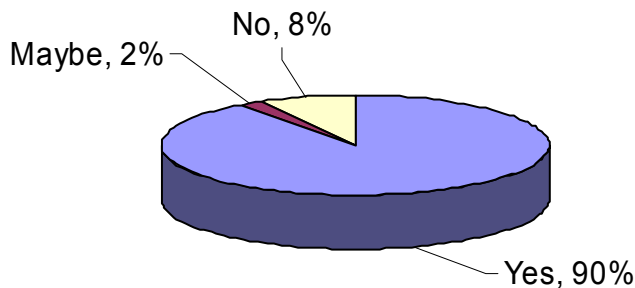


PARTICIPANT SATISFACTION SURVEY

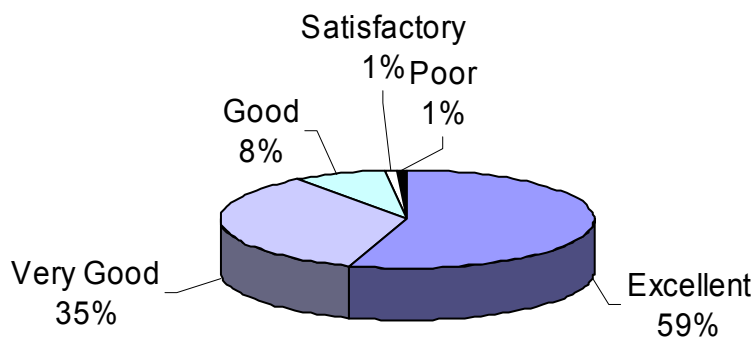
The data in this section is derived from a survey of 179 participants who attended one of the twelve workshops run in the summer of 2004; 154 participants returned the survey. Over 94 percent of the participants ranked their overall experience with the workshops as either excellent or very good. This ranking significantly exceeds the nominally 80 % satisfaction achieved during a previous UFE program run in Atlanta by Georgia State University and the Georgia Institute of Technology.

» *90% of the participants would recommend the workshop that they attended to a colleague, n=154.*

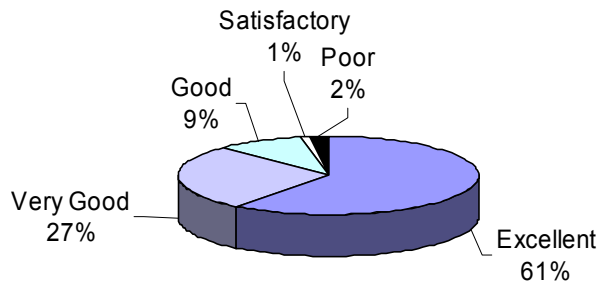
» *Participants were highly satisfied with the workshops - 94% of the participants rated the workshops as "excellent" or "very good"*



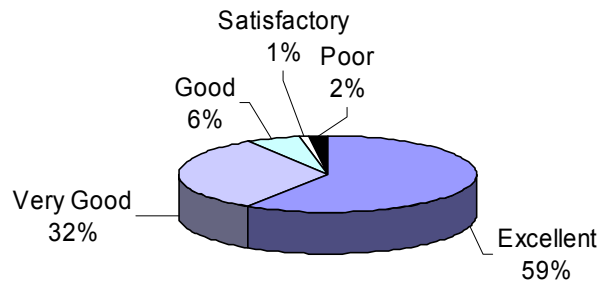
» *Approximately 90% of participants gave workshop organization, relevance, quality, and facilities a score of “excellent” or “very good”. Approximately 80 % of the participants ranked the accommodations as “excellent” or “very good” (note that in some cases campus dormitories were used for housing, in other cases chain hotels were used)*

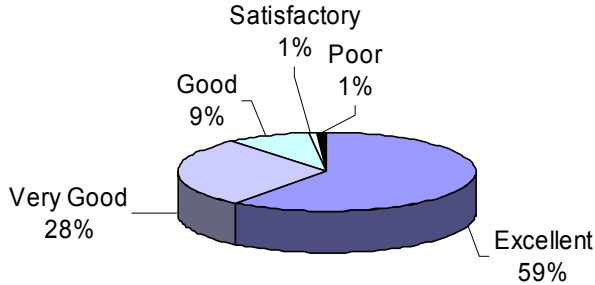
Relevance of materials presented
