Neuroscience Institute**

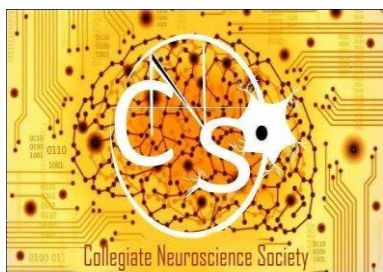
Come listen as Dr. Parent gives advice on how to join a research lab. She will also her talk about her research on how memory affects eating behavior and how obesity impacts memory.
